UNAPPROVED MINUTES

A regular meeting of the Shoreline Unified School District Board of Trustees was held at West Marin School on Thursday, September 10, 2015.

- 1. Jim Lino called the meeting to order at 5:04 p.m.
- 2. Board members present: Jim Lino, Monique Moretti, Clarette McDonald and Tim Kehoe. Board members absent: Jane Healy, Kegan Stedwell and Jill Manning-Sartori. Staff present: Superintendent Nancy Neu, Nancy Wolf, Adam Jennings, Matt Nagle, Jim Patterson, Bruce Abbott and Jeannie Moody.
- Approved and adopted the agenda. (McDonald/Kehoe AYES: Lino/Kehoe/Moretti/McDonald NOES: None ABSENT: Stedwell/Healy/Manning-Sartori ABSTAIN: None) Motion passes.
- Announced closed session items: 54957.6-Conference with Labor Negotiator, Nancy Neu, regarding classified and certificated negotiations; Education Code 35146-Student Discipline and Other Confidential Student Matters: Student ID# 26902 expulsion hearing.
- 5. No comments from the public on closed session items.
- 6. Recessed to closed session at 5:07 p.m.
- 7. Reconvened to public session at 6:00 p.m.
- 8. Jim Lino reported that during closed session the Board reviewed the conditions of the expulsion contract with student ID # 26902 and will implement a suspended expulsion for the 2015 fall semester.
- 9. Hana Cassel and Buddy Faure were honored as Shoreline's students of the month for September 2015. Mr. Eckert and Ms. Cassel made the presentations.
- 10. Student Representative Gabby Esquivias reported on all of the events and activities happening throughout the District. Jim Lino welcomed our new student representative and announced that this year the student representative will be able to participate in discussions and vote on action items prior to the official Board vote however, this vote will not affect the final numerical outcome of the Board vote.
- 11. Consent Agenda
 - 11.1. Minutes: Approved minutes of August 20, 2015, regular meeting.
 - 11.2. Approved warrants: General.
 - 11.3. Acceptance of gifts: To Bodega Bay School PTA: Bodega Bay Fisherman's Festival donated \$3,000, and Daniel Sneed of Freeport McMoran Oil and Gas donated \$500.00.

12. Approved request by Tomales High School seniors for off-campus lunch privilege for the 2015-16 school year. Principal Adam Jennings recommends.

13. Transportation Director George Borges reported that due to staffing shortages the bus routes in West Marin/Inverness have temporarily changed. He apologized for the confusion, lack of communication and the short notice but he was not made aware of drivers being out until the last minute. In the future Mr. Borges will utilize our School Messenger service to report any changes to the bus routes.

14. Ryan Corrigan our technology support for the district reported that Shoreline students are almost 1:1 with technology. The high school students have Chrome Books and the elementary schools have iPads. With the addition of this new technology we needed to upgrade our network. This is costly but necessary. Ryan's daily tasks have greatly increased with the additional technology but he is still accessible for the unforeseen trouble shooting district wide. He will be looking into ways to improve our video conferencing system at our board of trustee meetings.

Curriculum and Instruction

- 15. The principals' reported on upcoming events and activities at their sites. Principal Jennings has been meeting with the student representatives and going over the agenda with them. He is also teaching them about Brown Act rules. The elementary school principals reported on reading intervention programs at their individual sites.
- 16. Superintendent Nancy Neu reported that our student enrollment numbers are up from last year. She then shared that Kaiser Employees donated backpacks full of school supplies for needy students. Our district was able to distribute more than 50 of these backpacks throughout the district. Ms. Neu then reminded everyone of the back to school night dates, staff development days and the future adoption of a new math curriculum. This year we are piloting three different publishers' math materials which are aligned with the new Common Core standards.
- 17. Board of Trustees' Report Ms. Neu thanked Jill Manning-Sartori and Clarette McDonald for renewing their terms and Avito Miranda for filling the open seat in Trustee Area 1. Jill Manning-Sartori reminded the Board about the CSBA Conference in San Diego from 12/3 12/5; she will be attending.
- 18. Reviewed the inter-district transfer attendance report.
- 19. People addressing the Board on items not on the agenda: Peggy Day, a grandmother of a West Marin student is a school crossing guard and is looking for more volunteers. She is attempting to get us crossing guards from the West Marin Transportation Department, but she needs to prove that 500 cars pass by the school during school hours and that twelve students need to be crossed. Jolynn McClelland voiced her concerns about school safety; that a strange woman was able to enter classrooms unnoticed on two campuses is a sobering warning that our campuses and students are not safe. Ms. McClelland asked the Board to address this matter and to come up with a process, practice and/or policy to prevent it from ever happening again.

Provision of Certified Athletic Trainer & Other Sports Medicine Services San Rafael High School

Project Understanding/Purpose

Provide certified athletic training services to Tomales High School from October 2015 through June 31, 2015; including but not limited to, pre-game taping, game training supervision, athletic performance and sports medicine assistance services performed in connection with the school's athletic program.

Scope of Work

- 1. All services will be provided by a Certified Athletic Trainer.
- 2. Marin General Hospital's (MGH)certified athletic trainer (ATC) shall perform all of the duties associated with a Certified Athletic Trainer; including but not limited to sports medicine diagnosis and treatment, injury prevention, rehabilitation and the completion of all required Tomales City Schools injury documentation.
- 3. MGH shall arrange for and maintain baseline concussion testing for Tomales student athlete. Revolution's baseline concussion testing shall include ImPACT neuro-cognitive and BESS balance testing at a minimum. Revolution will also provide a concussion policy and protocol for San Rafael High School.
- 4. MGH's ATC will communicate in a timely manner with all athletes, parents and coaches.
- 5. The days of service will include Thanksgiving Break, Winter Break and Spring Break or calendared holidays when Tomales' athletes are practicing or competing.
- 6. Services will begin in October 2015 and concluding no later than end of June 2015 or when the last Tomales High School athletic competition has been completed, but no sooner than May 8, 2015.
- 7. MGH ATC will attend all away Football games.
- 8. Basic days of service will be Monday through Friday. Basic hours of service when school is in session will be from 2:30 PM until 7:30 PM. Service will be provided five hours per day and will not exceed ten (10) hours per week (Monday through Friday and Friday or Saturday game day). In addition, MGH ATC will also attend Friday and/or Saturday game day events. Basic hours will be from approximately 12 PM to 5 PM.
- 9. Basic hours of services will be adjusted during breaks or calendared holidays when Tomales athletes are practicing or competing.

At the completion of the semester, MGH will provide a written injury incidence report for the Tomales High School Athletic Department.

- \$40 per hour for weekend ATC services

TENTATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN SHORELINE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AND SHORELINE EDUCATION ASSOCIATION August 10th, 2015

The parties have met and agreed to the following changes to the current collective bargaining agreement beginning with 2015-2016.

Article V - Wages

5.1 Salary

For the 2015-16 school year the Certificated Salary Schedule shall be increased by four percent (4%) across the board.

For the 2016-17 school year the Certificated Salary Schedule shall be increased by two percent (2%) across the board.

For the 2017-18 school year the Certificated Salary Schedule shall be increased by two percent (2%) across the board.

Article VI - Health and Welfare Benefits

- 6.1 Delete and re-number.
- **6.2** 1 Effective October 1, 2013, The District shall offer the following plan for each full-time Certificated Employee.

Health: The district will offer a high-deductible high-premium (HDHP) — Health Savings Account (HSA) plan. The district will pay the total annual deductible into the health savings plan (Single -\$3,000; Plus one and Family - \$6,000) at the beginning of the 2015-16 school year. In subsequent years, the district will contribute an amount equal to the annual deductible at the beginning of each year. These funds will stay with the employee and unused funds will roll over each year. The district would cap Health and Welfare benefits at \$18,000 annually. In addition, the district will pay the cost of single

coverage for Dental, Vision and Life Insurance coverage. Employees can request additional coverage at their own cost.

When Bargaining unit members are married and are both eligible for Family or Plus one coverage, only one member may receive Family or Plus one coverage. The other member will be eligible to receive Single coverage, and the district will contribute the annual family deductible amount to the HSA for each bargaining unit member.

6.3 through 6.8 – No changes.

Article XVI – Completion of Agreement

16.1 - No change.

16.2 – No change.

16.3 This is a three (3) year closed agreement (2012-13, 2013-14, and 2014-15) (2015-16, 2016-17, and 2017-18).

This contract is an open and on-going agreement subject to revision at any time during the school year as mutually agreed upon by the Shoreline Unified School District and Shoreline Education Association.

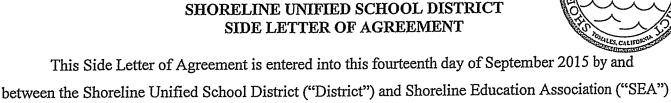

1. On August 10, 2015, the parties met and reached a Tentative Agreement covering the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2018.

to clarify the intent of the parties in connection with the August 10, 2015 Tentative Agreement.

- 2. The parties agree that there is a need to clarify a couple items related to Article VI Health and Welfare Benefits which are as follows:
 - a. For the 2015-2016 year only, the District will double the amount paid into a unit member's Health Savings Account ("HSA") which will be \$3,000 for single and \$6,000 for employee plus one and family. In 2016-2017 and future years, the District's contributions will be equal to the annual deductible at the beginning of the year (currently \$1,500 for single and \$3,000 for employee plus one and family).
 - b. For the 2015-2016 year only, for those unit members who are married and employees of the District, the District will only pay the \$6,000 for each member of the married couple into a single HSA. In 2016-2017 and future years, the ongoing payment into the HSA shall be \$3,000 for each member of the married couple into a single HSA.
 - c. In connection with the double HSA payment for married couples, for 2015-2016 as referenced in 2b above, and since the HSA payment exceeds the amount statutorily authorized, the amount exceeding the statutory amount will be treated as additional wages for the married couple.

3.	This Side Letter of Agreement is non-precedent setting and is provided for the sole purpose to

The purpose of the Joint Committee will be to ensure the funds spent by the Shoreline District and its employees provides the best insurance coverage possible within the financial constraints of the Shoreline district and its employees.

The Joint Committee will be responsible for annually reviewing the packages and rates provided by our insurance carriers and making recommendations to the Superintendent on changes that could improve service without additional cost or reduce cost without reducing service. Any recommendations that required changes to the Association's contract will need to be negotiated as part of the established negotiation process.

The Joint Committee will be comprised of 2 SEA members, 2 CSEA members, a member of the administrative team and the CBO. The Committee will meet as needed during the spring of each year as rate information for the upcoming year becomes available.

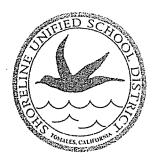

Subject: Budget narrative for 2st update 2015-16 budget

This the second update to the Shoreline budget. This budget update reflects the following changes.

- Impact of the tentative agreement with the Shoreline Education Association
- Booking of the Marin Community Fund Pre K-3 Initiative grant carry over funds
- Miscellaneous updates to personnel budget

With the board approval of the tentative agreement with the Shoreline Education Association the salary schedule for the certificated staff will be increased by 4% in 2015-16, 2% in 2016-17 and 2% in 2017-18. Correspondently the district contribution for health care will change from the Kaiser \$20 copay plan to the Kaiser high deductible plan with the district paying the deductible into a health savings account. In the first year of the agreement the district will double up the contribution to the health savings account. The contribution from the district going forward will have a hard cap of \$18,000.

With the new practice of only booking carryover funds when there is a plan to actually use the funds recommendations for budget updates will be made as needed. With the closing of the books for 2014-15 \$57,163 was identified as carryover for the Marin Community Fund Pre K-3 Initiative grant. These funds need to be spent in 2015-16 and are now budgeted to Tomales Elementary and West Marin/Inverness. Carryover funds represent restricted funds unused in prior year. When budgeted into current year they are expenses without matching revenue and have a negative onetime impact on current year restricted bottom line.

Since the first update there have been some changes to the personnel budget. Primarily position being filled so actual salaries replace estimated salaries and more specific planning of stipend has been completed. The net impact to the personnel related budget lines is a reduction of \$3,534.

There have been a couple recent changes from Sacramento that did not make the deadline for this budget update but are worth noting. These changes will be included in the next budget update which is expected to be submitted with the first interim report.

As part of the 2015-16 state budget the state legislators and the governor created the Educator Effectiveness Program. This program allocates one time restrictive funds to school districts to be used for:

- Beginning teacher, administrator support and mentoring, including programs that support new teacher and administrator ability to teach or lead effectively and to meet induction requirements adopted by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing;
- Professional development, coaching, and support services for teachers who have been identified as needing improvement or additional support;
- Professional development for teachers and administrators that is aligned to state-adopted content standards; and
- To promote educator quality and effectiveness that may include training on mentoring and coaching certificated staff to support effective teaching and learning.

Shoreline Unified has been allocated \$81,539.

The governor recently signed SB 597 extending the District of Choice program for an additional year 2016-17. This program allows Shoreline to receive some of the state fund allocated to students that are being served by our district while residing outside our district. The program was expected to sunset at the end of 2015-16 but analysis on the success of the program was not completed. The year extension will allow enough time to complete the analysis and potentially support a long term extension of the program.

There were no changes to the other funds in Shoreline.

Following are the major changes impacting the 2015-16 budget, attached is a spreadsheet reflecting the same changes.

Revenue:

No changes are reflected in this update.

Certificated staff:

Changes in salary as open positions are filled with actual staff with specific salary amounts rather than estimates and planned expense carryover for MCF grant produced an overall decrease of \$3,534.

Changes in the SEA salary schedule and certificated management increased expense \$168,091.

Subject: Substitute Teacher Rate

Attracting quality substitute teachers for the Shoreline District is essential to provide excellent educational service to our students. Shoreline needs to offer a competitive rate given the challenges of the distance most substitutes must travel. After reviewing rates across Marin County it is recommended that we increase our rate from \$130 per day to \$150 per day. Impact to the budget would be approximately \$10,000 to \$15,000.

GOVERNING BOARD ELECTIONS

Any person is eligible to be a member of the Board of Trustees, without further qualifications, if he/she is 18 years of age or older, a citizen of California, a resident of the school district, a registered voter, and not legally disqualified from holding civil office. Any person who has been convicted of a felony involving the giving, accepting, or offering of a bribe, embezzlement or theft of public funds, extortion, perjury, or conspiracy to commit any such crime, under California law or the law of another state, the United States of America, or another country, is not eligible to be a candidate for office or be a Board member except when he/she has been granted a pardon in accordance with law. (Education Code 35107; Elections Code 20)

A district employee elected to the Board shall resign his/her employment before being sworn in or shall have his/her employment automatically terminated upon being sworn into office. (Education Code 35107)

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To reduce costs associated with conducting elections, the Board may consolidate Board elections with the local municipal or statewide primary or general election. Board election procedures shall be conducted in accordance with state and federal law.

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Electing Board Members

The district is divided into three trustee areas. Each trustee area shall be represented by a Board member trustees who resides in and is elected by voters residing within that trustee area. Trustee areas shall be balanced by population as required by state and federal law. Trustee area 1 has three trustees, Trustee area 2 has two trustees, and Trustee area 3 has two trustees. Each trustee area election, when required, will be a separate election but all registered voters of the district can vote in all trustee areas.

Prior to March 1 following the year in which the results of each decennial federal census are released, the Board shall adjust the boundaries of the district's trustee areas based on population figures as validated by the Population Research Unit of the Department of Finance. (Education Code 5019.5)

If the Board determines that a change is necessary, it shall adopt a resolution at an open meeting specifying the change(s) and shall, in accordance with Education Code 5019 or other applicable provisions of law, obtain approval from the county committee on school district organization having jurisdiction over the district.

Campaign Conduct

In order to help protect the public's trust in the electoral process as well as the public's confidence in the Board and district, the Board encourages all candidates to sign and adhere to the principles in the Code of Fair Campaign Practices pursuant to Elections Code 20440.

(cf. 0410 - Nondiscrimination in District Programs and Activities) (cf. 9005 - Governance Standards)

Statement of Qualifications

The district shall assume no part of the cost of printing, handling, translating, or mailing of candidate statements filed pursuant to Elections Code 13307. As a condition of having candidate statements included in the voter's pamphlet, the district may require candidates to pay their estimated pro rata share of these costs to the district in advance pursuant to Elections Code 13307.

On the 125th day prior to the day fixed for the general district election, the Board secretary or his/her designee shall deliver a notice, bearing the secretary's signature and district seal, to the county elections official describing both of the following: (Elections Code 10509)

- 1. The elective offices of the district to be filled at the general election and which offices, if any, are for the balance of an unexpired term
- 2. Whether the district or the candidate is to pay for the publication of a statement of qualifications pursuant to Elections Code 13307

(cf. 9223 - Filling Vacancies)

Candidate statements shall be limited to no more than 200 words. (Elections Code 13307)

Tie Votes in Board Member Elections

Note: Education Code 5016 requires the Board to decide, before conducting any election, whether a potential tie will be resolved by lot or with a runoff election. Option 1 is for use by districts that will make this determination prior to each election. For districts that do not re-determine the method at each election, Option 2 provides for the use of lots to determine the winner in case of a tie in every election while Option 3 provides for a runoff election.

Education Code 5016 requires the County Superintendent of Schools to provide certification of a tie vote in an election to the district Board.

OPTION 1: Before each election, the Board shall establish whether a potential tie is to be resolved by lot or with a runoff election. (Education Code 5016)

After an election for which the Board has decided to resolve a tie by lot, the Board shall immediately notify the candidates who re-i---1 the tie votes of the time and place where the -72-

GOVERNING BOARD ELECTIONS (continued)

candidates or their representatives should appear before the Board. The Board at that time shall determine the winner by lot. (Education Code 5016)

After an election for which the Board has decided to resolve a tie with a runoff election, the Board shall schedule the runoff election in accordance with law. (Education Code 5016)

OPTION 2: Whenever a tie makes it impossible to determine which of two or more candidates has been elected to the Board, the Board shall immediately notify the candidates who received the tie votes of the time and place where the candidates or their representatives should appear before the Board. The Board at that time shall determine the winner by lot. (Education Code 5016)

OPTION 3: Whenever a tie makes it impossible to determine which of two or more candidates has been elected to the Board, the Board shall schedule a runoff election in accordance with law. (Education Code 5016)

REMUNERATION, REIMBURSEMENT AND OTHER BENEFITS

Compensation

The members of the Governing Board view their Board service as a voluntary contribution to the community and elect not to receive the compensation to which they are entitled pursuant to Education Code 35120.

Student Board members shall receive no compensation for meetings attended. (Education Code 35012)

Whenever a quorum of Board members serves as another legislative body which will meet simultaneously or in serial order to a Board meeting, the Board clerk or a member of the Board shall verbally announce the amount of any additional compensation or stipend that each member will be entitled to receive as a result of convening the simultaneous or serial meeting. (Government Code 54952.3)

Reimbursement of Expenses

Board members shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred when performing authorized services for the district. Expenses for travel, telephone, business meals, or other authorized purposes shall be in accordance with policies established for district personnel and at the same rate of reimbursement.

Board members shall be reimbursed for travel expenses incurred when performing services directed by the Board. (Education Code 35044)

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Authorized purposes may include, but are not limited to, attendance at educational seminars or conferences designed to improve Board members' skills and knowledge; participation in regional, state, or national organizations whose activities affect the district's interests; attendance at district or community events; and meetings with state or federal officials on issues of community concern.

Personal expenses shall be the responsibility of individual Board members. Personal expenses include, but are not limited to, the personal portion of any trip, tips or gratuities, alcohol, entertainment, laundry, expenses of any family member who is accompanying the Board member on district-related business, personal use of an automobile, and personal losses and traffic violation fees incurred while on district business.

REMUNERATION, REIMBURSEMENT AND OTHER BENEFITS (continued)

Any questions regarding the propriety of a particular type of expense should be resolved by the Superintendent or designee before the expense is incurred.

Board members may use district-issued credit cards while on official district business and consistent with the limits established for district personnel. Personal expenses shall not be charged on a district-issued credit card, even if the Board member intends to subsequently reimburse the district for the personal charges.

Health and Welfare Benefits for Current Board Members

Health and welfare benefits for Board members shall be no greater than that received by the district's non-safety employees with the most generous schedule of benefits. (Government Code 53208.5)

The district shall pay the premiums required for Board members electing to participate in the district health and welfare benefits program to the same extent that it pays for district employees *for individual coverage*.

Health and welfare benefits provided to Board members shall be extended at the same level to their spouse/registered domestic partner and to their eligible dependent children as specified in law and the health plan.

Health and Welfare Benefits for Board members newly elected after November 1, 2015

Board members elected after Novemebr 1, 2015, may participate in the health and welfare benefits program provided for district employees under the conditions specified below.

Health and welfare benefits for former Board members shall be no greater than those received by district non-safety employees with the most generous schedule of benefits. (Government Code 53208.5)

Board members newly elected after November 1, 2015, may participate in the health and welfare benefits program at his/her own expense. (Government Code 53201)

REMUNERATION, REIMBURSEMENT AND OTHER BENEFITS (continued)

Health and Welfare Benefits for Former Board Members

Former Board members may participate in the health and welfare benefits program provided for district employees under the conditions specified below.

Health and welfare benefits for former Board members shall be no greater than those received by district non-safety employees with the most generous schedule of benefits. (Government Code 53208.5)

The district shall pay the premiums for health and welfare benefits of any former Board member who served in office after January 1, 1981, began his/her term before January 1, 1995, and has served for 12 or more years. (Government Code 53201)

Any other Former Board members who served at least one term may participate in the health and welfare benefits program at his/her own expense if coverage is in effect at the time he/she leaves office. (Government Code 53201)

Hi Jeannie,

It was, as it turns out, in the Education Code. We've always conducted Shoreline's elections under subsection (c).

Education Code 5030

"Except as provided in Sections 5027 and 5028, in any school district or community college district having trustee areas, the county committee on school district organization and the registered voters of a district, pursuant to Sections 5019 and 5020, respectively, may at any time recommend one of the following alternate methods of electing governing board members:

- (a) That each member of the governing board be elected by the registered voters of the entire district.
- (b) That one or more members residing in each trustee area be elected by the registered voters of that particular trustee area.

(c) That each governing board member be elected by the registered voters of the entire school district or community college district, but reside in the trustee area which he or she represents.

The recommendation shall provide that any affected incumbent member shall serve out his or her term of office and that succeeding board members shall be nominated and elected in accordance with the method recommended by the county committee.

Whenever trustee areas are established in a district, provision shall be made for one of the alternative methods of electing governing board members.

In counties with a population of less than 25,000, the county committee on school district organization or the county board of education, if it has succeeded to the duties of the county committee, may at any time, by resolution, with respect to trustee areas established for any school district, other than a community college district, amend the provision required by this section without additional approval by the electors, to require one of the alternate methods for electing board members to be utilized."
