AGREEMENT FOR ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT SERVICES AT TOMALES HIGH SCHOOL

This AGREEMENT for Administrative Support Services at Tomales High School is by and between the Shoreline Unified School District (hereinafter referred to as the "District") and the Marin County Superintendent of Schools (hereinafter referred to as the "Superintendent).

The parties agree as follows:

- 1. The District will use the services of the Superintendent's staff for Administrative Support Services at Tomales High School.
- The District shall pay the Superintendent a daily rate of \$ 666.00 including related payroll costs and mileage for 44 (forty-four) days for these services, for a total of \$ 32,528.12. A schedule of salary costs is attached. The Superintendent agrees to contribute one-third of the costs in the amount of \$ 10,842.71.
- 3. This Agreement will begin on April 16, 2012 and will continue through June 15, 2012.
